APPOINTMENTS OF NEW MANAGEMENT EXECUTIVES

Lereno Bio-Chem Ltd ("**LBC**") is pleased to announce that the biodiesel plant in Lumut Malaysia owned 38% by LBC is operational and currently, LBC is involved in negotiating substantial stakes in several oil palm plantation resources in both Indonesia and Malaysia. LBC had also announced on 7 September 07 on the award and handing over to LBC by JTC Corporation of a 3.4 hectare piece of land in Jurong Island for our biofuel and oleochemical production facilities.

In view of the imminent nature of these business activities, LBC is pleased to announce the appointments of the following senior staff positions within the LBC group of companies (the "**Group**"):

1. Dr. Ubbo von Oehsen has been appointed as the Senior Vice President/ Head of Technical Planning and Procurement with LBC's wholly owned subsidiary. Dr von Oehsen will be part of the Group's Operations team to manage and develop the Group's plants in biofuel, oleochemical and palm oil production.

Dr. von Oehsen graduated from the Technical University of Clausthal, Germany in 1975 with a degree M.Sc. in Chemistry and in 1980, he obtained his Ph.D in physical chemistry from the University of Hannover, Germany.

Dr. von Oehsen has 25 years of experience in manufacturing of polymers and specialty chemicals, planning and execution of capital investment projects, plant start-up, engineering, evaluating chemical processes and project applications, process and product development, warehousing, quality management, transfer of technology, developing and implementing business strategies and joint development projects with customers.

He was with BASF Aktiengesellschaft, Ludwigshafen/Germany from 1980 to 2005, holding the position of Vice President. During this period, he also held several functions in research and development, engineering and production of chemicals with BASF Indonesia, Jakarta, Indonesia (from 1990 to 1996).

2. Mr Edwin Lau Chung Loong will be appointed as Senior Vice President, Plantation Development (Acting Head). In this position, Mr Lau will be guiding and managing the acquisitions and development of the various substantial oil palm estates which the Group will be involved in/acquiring as part of its planned upstream development.

Mr Lau holds a Bachelor of Science in Business Management from Oklahoma City University, Oklahoma, USA (1993).

He has over 36 years of working experience in oil palm plantation management and was with the Sarawak Government service since 1970. He was also the Plantation Advisor of Bumi Suria Ventures Sdn Bhd and the Group Development Plantation Advisor of PELITA Holdings Sdn Bhd. He is a member of the Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP) since 1984.

While in Government service, he was the Government representative in the Board of Directors of Sarawak Oil Palms Berhad, Rimwood Pelita Plantation Sdn Bhd, Crop Research & Application Unit Sdn Bhd (CRAUN); and Mayang Tea Sdn Bhd (some of which owns large oil palm plantations in East Malaysia).

3. Mr Eric Lue Kok Keong will be appointed as Vice President, Business Development of LBC. Mr Lue will be part of the Group's Business Development team and will assist LBC's directors in the expansion of the Group's business objectives.

Mr Lue graduated with a Bachelor of Business (Honours) in Marketing and International Business from the Queensland University of Technology in Australia (1998); and a Graduate Diploma in Financial Management from SIM University.

Lue has 10 years of business development and strategic marketing experience, including being with Singapore Petroleum Company from 2000 to 2006. His previous job experience includes working in business development activities across the Asia Pacific and the Oceania region.
