### **SIGNING OF BUILDING AGREEMENT FOR LAND FOR THE PROPOSED BIODIESEL AND GLYCERINE REFINING PLANT AND A BIOETHANOL FINISHING PLANT TO BE BUILT ON JURONG ISLAND**

---

Lereno Bio-Chem Ltd (the "Company") had on 7 September 2007, announced the acceptance of the letter of offer by the Company's subsidiary, Lereno BC (Singapore) Pte Ltd ("LBCS") from Jurong Town Corporation ("JTC") on the allocation of approximately 34,000 sq metres of land for the proposed biodiesel and glycerine refining plant and a bioethanol finishing plant to be built on Jurong Island.

Possession of the land took place on 10 September 2007.

Pursuant to the letter of offer, the Company is now pleased to announce that the Building Agreement dated 6 November 2007 has been signed between JTC and LBCS on 30 November 2007 (the "Building Agreement").

LBCS shall be granted a lease of the land and buildings for an initial term of 30 years with retrospective effect from 9 October 2007 and an option for a further term of 30 years subject to compliance with the terms and conditions in the Building Agreement.

Currently, the Company and LBCS are in negotiations with potential international partners for cooperation for the Jurong Island facilities and preparation is underway for the facilities to be built.
